APPLICATION: Library Patrons, Staff, Trustees, Volunteers

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

The Bristol Library affirms its support of equal access for persons with disabilities and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, Public Law 101-336 (ADA), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability. The ADA, as applied to cities, counties, and other local governmental entities, requires that no qualified individual with a disability shall, on the basis of a disability, be denied the benefits of local government services, programs, or activities.

POLICY: In accordance with ADA policy, the Bristol Library will

- Take appropriate steps to ensure that communications with applicants, participants and members of the public with disabilities are accessible.
- Make reasonable accommodations in policies, practices or procedures when necessary to avoid discrimination on the basis of disability.
- Operate its programs so that, when viewed in their entirety, are readily accessible to and usable by individuals with disabilities.

RESPONSIBILITY: The Board of Trustees is responsible for establishing the Library's ADA Compliance Policy for patrons. The Manager is responsible for enforcing the policy.
